This seminar is excellent for anyone who is now serving in or anticipates joining an ESL ministry. It is also appropriate for those who are planning such a ministry within their community or as part of a mission trip.

The instructor is Mrs. Jan Nelson of Chapelgate Presbyterian Church in Marriottsville, MD. She is a graduate of Bryan College who holds a Masters in Teaching from Notre Dame of Maryland and received her ESL Teacher Training Certification from Oklahoma Baptist University. She is certified by the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Church and is authorized by her denomination (PCA) to train others in ESL ministry.

This 10-hour seminar will cover a broad range of topics, including: organizing an ESL ministry; student assessment and placement; basic teaching techniques; lesson plans; resolving cultural misunderstandings; etc. Students attending all 10 hours will receive a completion certificate. (This is NOT an add-on certificate for teachers in public schools.)

The registration fee is \$35 per person, including the instruction manual, continental breakfast and lunch on Saturday, plus snacks and beverages during the breaks. Alumni can bring their own manuals and register for \$15 per person.
